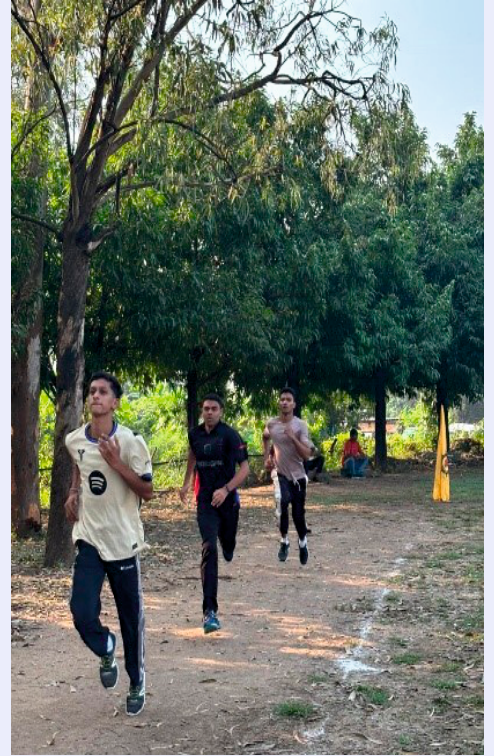
2. A Mooring course was conducted for OERC candidates at our campus on the 7th of October 2025.
